Little Mathematicians – Big Mathematics

Debby reviewed graphing maps, the second last session of the Little Mathematicians' program.

The activity was divided into three parts and the first part was easy and fun. It involved collecting data on how to get to



Treasure Cove from pirates (secondary students). The second part was very confusing and perplexing as we tried to make sense of the data and put it into a map. From the map, we had a bigger task mapping how to get to Treasure Cove from any of the other five places. We struggled to think of a way to solve this part until one of the secondary student teachers gave us a clue – working backwards and having a guess as well. It took over 20 minutes but we found a way. There were seven other ways! Aaliyah and Pukal really enjoyed this because they found a solution before us (Debby and Puka)

Debby 4B

Aaliyah, Debby, Pukal and Ruby, from grade 4, have attended four sessions of extension mathematics at John Monash Secondary School. All four girls have loved the experience of working with Year 10 and 11 students and they enjoyed the encounter of “doing something



you would not usually associate with mathematics” (Debby). “Yes, it was very different from what we normally do in school maths.” (Pukal) “It was confusing, hard and very challenging.” (Aaliyah) “The coding was easiest; the card shuffling was the hardest and the graphing was the most enjoyable but still quite puzzling.” (Ruby) The one thing the four girls all agreed that they gained from attending the program was that Mathematics can be used in many parts of life and there is not necessary one answer, in fact, there are a number of answers! The girls said once they understood that they found it easier to work together looking for loops. The sessions were very exciting for me as a teacher as I saw the students working co-operatively to investigate situations using mathematics. They began to understand that mathematics is a way of thinking about life, and not just finding an answer to algorithms.
