The students in Prep – 2 are going to an advanced screening of the movie – Ralph Breaks the Internet, then they will be heading to Ballam Park for a play before returning to school.

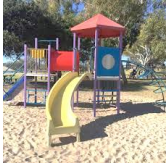


Grades 3 & 4

Locked Box Challenge

On Tuesday 20th of November 2018 Lakshethaa Rajan, from 6B represented Lyndale Greens Primary School in the Lyndale Secondary College Pro-Am STEM Locked Box Challenge.

In this challenge she was partnered with a year 11 student so that they could complete a series of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) based challenges. The solution to each challenge revealed the combination to a padlock. The winner of the challenge was the first pair that successfully solved all 6 problems to open the 6 padlocks so that they could gain access to the locked box.



Lakshethaa and her partner worked cooperatively and applied their knowledge to solve a number of challenging STEM problems. Lakshethaa should be very proud of her efforts and for representing our school so well.
